India is the second most populous country with 1,379,056,148 inhabitants. India's flag has three stripes of three different colours which are orange, white and green. Orange or saffron or Bhagwa symbolizes courage, sacrifice and renunciation or disinterest. White in the centre is the symbol of truth and purity in thoughts. And finally, green is a reminder of plants and nature which everybody needs to live and of prosperity. In the middle of the white stripe, we can see a blue symbol which is called the Ashoka Chakra which represents the spinning wheel which symbolizes progress and movement.
